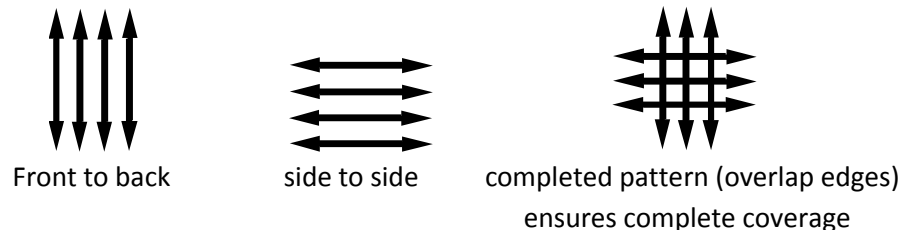


Instructions for applying InvisaBLOCK™ Sealer

1. Thoroughly clean the stone's surface with denatured alcohol before sealing. This is very important to the sealer's performance.
2. After stone has been cleaned with denatured alcohol, use InvisaBLOCK Premium Stone Cleaner provided in kit to further clean surface. Wipe clean with paper towels.
3. Remove InvisaBLOCK Sealer bottle and blue foam applicator from kit. Apply sealer to black foam side of applicator being careful not to over soak the foam.
4. Wipe sealer onto stone using arms length strokes starting front to back, and then going over the same area side to side. Repeat this process adding sealer to applicator as needed, until entire area to be sealed has been coated once. Work an area of about 2 feet at a time, overlapping areas as you move down counter.



****important:** be sure to also coat inside of holes drilled for plumbing or other accessories**

5. Return to starting point and apply a second coat of sealer. If stone being sealed is a light color or has a more porous finish, apply additional coats of sealer, until bottle of sealer is empty.
6. After stone has received a minimum of two coats of sealer, continue to go over stone with applicator several times using the same front to back and side to side technique. **DO NOT** add any additional sealer to applicator. This step will help get all the sealer into the pores of the stone. You will see the stone become dry as you repeat this process. (*DO NOT wipe off sealer with a rag.)
7. Inform customer to keep surface dry for at least 2 hours and wipe up any spills immediately for 24 hours.
8. Inform customer that nothing should be put back on countertop for at least 24 hours. Placing items on stones surface before 24 hours has passed can prevent the sealer from drying properly.

Please note, the stone may become dark when applying the sealer. This is normal and the stone will return to its natural color once the sealer has completely cured. Depending on climate, this can take up to 7-10 days.

Sealer bottle will cover up to 80 sq.ft. of polished stone. It will cover less area on more porous types of finishes such as honed, brushed, or flamed stones.
